1.  **Keep your passwords private**
Don't share your login information with anyone—not even close friends.

2.  **Check your privacy settings**
Review your app and account settings to limit what others can see.

3. **Be kind online**
Treat others with respect and avoid jokes or comments that could hurt someone.

4.  **Avoid unknown links**
Suspicious links could lead to harmful websites or expose your personal data.

5.  **Speak up if something feels wrong**
Talk to a trusted adult—a teacher, parent, or counselor—if you feel unsafe or uncomfortable online.

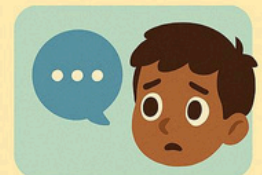
